### CONTEXT

Manitoba was one of the better graded provinces in 2023, but it has since declined. While it is understandable that a new government will need time to find footing, the clock is ticking and many people in the province are struggling with unprecedented rates of poverty and food insecurity.

## **KEY FINDINGS**

#### AN IMPOSSIBLE HOUSING MARKET

Historically the province with the most affordable housing, 2 in 5 Manitobans this year are spending 30% or more of their income on housing.

#### **INEQUALITY AND POVERTY**

**20% of First Nations people** in Manitoba live in poverty, nearly twice the rate for the province as a whole.

### UNPRECEDENTED FOOD INSECURITY

More than a quarter (27%) of residents are food insecure and children represent 2 in 5 food bank clients.

## SELECT POLICY RECOMMENDATIONS

- **1.** Establish a \$100 million annual Manitoba Builds program modelled on the BC Builds program.
- **2.** Present a poverty reduction strategy for all Manitobans, with a particular focus on single people and Indigenous peoples.
- **3.** Raise the minimum wage to match Ontario's.
